Feast of All Saints: Friday is the 1st November and the Feast of All Saints. Traditionally it is a Holy Day in the church calendar. Mass times are as follows:
Clarecastle: 1st November 10am & 7pm - Ballyea: 8pm

Feast of All Souls: *Saturday 2nd November.* Clarecastle 10am. The evening mass at 7pm will be the mass of the 31st Sunday of the year. Sunday masses will be at the usual times.

November Masses: To facilitate those who wish to attend mass in November in remembrance of their dead, evening masses dure November will be on the following evenings: Clarecastle – Wednesday – 7pm ~ Ballyea – Friday – 8pm
